Voters User Manual

Introduction

When voters open the application (<https://baloti.org/>), the landing page will be like below.




Figure 1 – baloti landing page

Here the voter can see the Vote Now button at the bottom and at the same time a Login button, which is highlighted in red colour.

Buttons & Features

- **EN** – The option for the Voter to select the available language
- **Burger Menu** – The 3 vertical lines placed between the Language button and the Login button.
- **Login** – For login into the application.
- **Vote Now** – For going directly to the voting page
- **How it Works** – To know the process, by clicking the application scrolls down to the page.

Login

By clicking on the **login button**, the Voter will be directed to the login page. Here the Voter/user can see the option to login/register – if it is for the first time.




Figure 2 – Register/Login

For Login, the Voter has to enter the valid email id and password, as shown below and click on the button "**Continue**".




Figure 3 – Login

If registering, the Voter needs to click on the "**Create an account now**", here the Voter will have two options to register, have to give the Facebook login credential or give voters personal email id and a mail will be sent to the voter for confirmation.




Figure 4 - Register/Create an account

After entering the email id, the voter needs to click on the "send" button. Then a screen will appear below.




Figure 5 - Success mail send

Here as shown in the above screen the voter clicks on the "Login Now" button and enter the id and password that the voter will receive through the mail.

Now the voter has to open the personal inbox to find the baloti created voter's user id and a temporary password for login.




Figure 6 - Registration Mail

Now the voter needs to click on the **Continue button**. And now a new window will appear or can directly go to baloti application and click on 'Login now' button.




Figure 7 - 1st Login

Here the voter can login to the application by entering the valid credentials.

The voter now reached the dashboard and can view all referendums that are opened, closed for the voter.

The highlighted above parts are the options for voters for filtering and searching.

To vote in a referendum, the voter needs to click on any respective "Vote Now" button. By clicking on it a detailed page for the respective referendum will appear.

By clicking on the highlighted part of the above image on the top right **avatar icon**, a slider will appear, where the voter can change the current temporary password.

By clicking on the '**Change Password**' a new page will appear as below.




Figure 10 - Change Password

Here the voter can enter the old and the new required. Password. After re-entering the password, the voter needs to click on the continue button.



Figure 11- Vote Now

To vote, the voter needs to click on the Vote Now button, which is highlighted in red on the above screen. Then the voter will be directed to the detailed page.




Figure 12 - Referendum detailed page

The voter has to vote on two issues, as the referendum is having two issues. Here once the voter has finished all issues in a referendum then the voting will get completed.

When the voter clicks on "**Vote Now**" for any issues a page will appear as below.




Figure 13- Voting

The default one will be 'Yes' among the option. The voter can change as per his decision. After the decision can click on the "Create Ballot" for successful voting or can click on the 'back' button for returning to the selected referendum page.

By clicking "Create Ballot" a pop-up will appear as below, for the voter's confirmation.




Figure 14 - Voter confirmation

By clicking the 'Confirm' button, another success mentioning pop-up will appear. By clicking **close** the pop-up disappears, and the voter can choose the option.




Figure 15 - Voting Success

By clicking on the 'Back to referendum', the voter will be directed to the dashboard. And if the voter re-opens the referendum which is last voted, can see status as "Voted".




Figure 16 - Voted status
